Why 0-6?

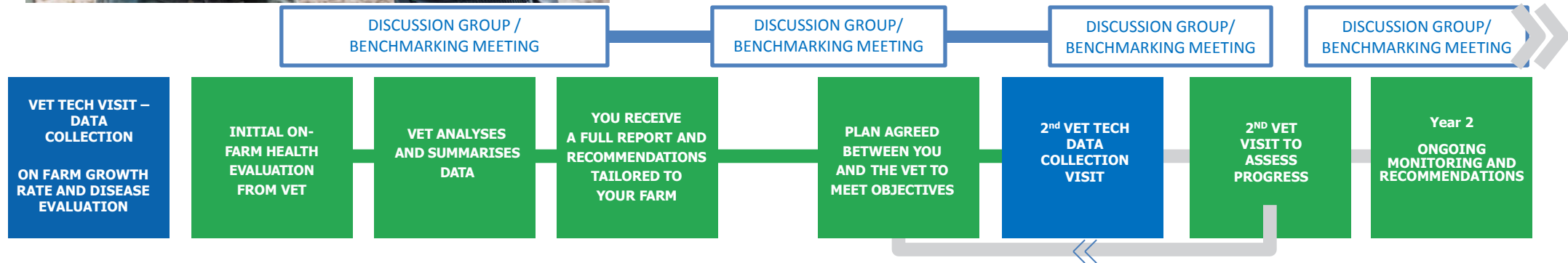
Improved youngstock husbandry and nutrition in months 0-6 reduces mortality and improves health.

HOW THE 0-6 YOUNGSTOCK ADVISORY SERVICE WORKS



How it Works

A vet-tech will visit your farm to weigh-tape calves and collect treatment and mortality data.

A vet will then visit to assess calf health and identify calf problems and disease within the framework of your calf-rearing objectives.

Our vets will evaluate all aspects of calf management, health care and nutrition to identify both strengths and areas for improvement.

This will enable you to:

- Better understand your current situation
- Monitor the performance of your calves
- Focus attention on problems that should be addressed.

Synergy Farm Health vets will also anonymously compare your data to other farms in the database, enabling you to assess your progress against other similar farms.



From this Synergy Farm Health will provide a summary report outlining the findings from your farm assessment. A recommended course of action will then be tailored to your farm with the support of your 0-6 Synergy Farm Health vet.

A second vet-tech visit within the 12 month period will re-examine growth rates and disease incidence. After analysing the data, a vet will again visit to discuss progress and make further recommendations. In subsequent years there will be twice-yearly data gathering and advice given as necessary. All subscribers to the 0-6 Youngstock Advisory Service will get the chance to attend three discussion group meetings per year on a range of calf-related topics.
